BUENOS AIRES A R G E N T I N A

DAY 1 | ... / BUENOS AIRES

· City Tour.

Arrival at Ezeiza International Airport and shuttle to the hotel in Buenos Aires downtown.

In the afternoon we will do a city tour to visit the main attractions. Buenos Aires is one of the most elegant cities in Latin America and the one that captures the essence of Argentinians.

In this half-day tour we will visit Plaza de Mayo, the political heart of the city. Important historical buildings are located here: Cabildo, The Metropolitan Cathedral and the Casa Rosada (seat of the Argentine national government).

We will then go south to visit one of the most influential neighborhoods in the porteño culture: La Boca. The streets of this neighborhood are full of life thanks to their beautiful colorful houses. We will get in the heart of the tango culture and visit the markets of the world famous Caminito Street.

Our tour will then go north, where we will visit the most elegant neighborhoods, such as Palermo, Barrio Norte and Recoleta, where the oldest cemetery of Buenos Aires and Eva Peron's mausoleum are located.

The end of our tour will be in Puerto Madero, the regenerated portside neighborhood. This is the most exclusive and luxurious area of the city, with modern skyscrapers in front of the Río de La Plata river.

Return to the hotel.

- Gaucho Party.

After breakfast we move out of the city to learn about the culture of the gaucho and the Argentine countryside.

We will visit a typical ranch in the Province of Buenos Aires, where we enjoy carriage rides, horseback riding and demonstrations of gaucho skills.

We will start the day with a glass of wine tasting the traditional "Argentine empanadas" of meat. Then at noon is the time for one of the experiences that everyone who visits Argentina should enjoy: the typical "Asado Argentino" (Argentine barbecue), good wine, music and folk dances, all this in a live show at lunchtime.

In the afternoon we will know part of the culture of the gaucho and his handling of the horse.

After the field day, we will return to the city of Buenos Aires.

DAY 3 | BS AS / TIGRE / BS AS**B/-/D**

- Tour to El Tigre.
- Boating through the delta of the Paraná River.
- Puerto de Frutos.
- Tango Show with dinner.

Outing day along the Delta of Paraná River, with almost 5000 km it is one of the longest rivers in the world and the most important in the region.

We will leave the hotel after breakfast and head to the city of Tigre, located only 30 km from Buenos Aires.

Once there we will take a boat with a professional guide and go all over this region of wetlands and islands. This region is considered one of the densest of the world along with Amazon, Nile and Ganges. We will sail for about 90 minutes along 5 channels that snake between islands that now have houses and different constructions, such as museums and national heroes' houses, yacht clubs and parks. Tigre offers a charming and natural landscape close to one of the main metropolises of Latin America.

Once the tour is completed, we will return to the dock and have part of the afternoon free to walk around the pier and the traditional Puerto de Frutos, a big open-air market, where regional products and handcrafts can be found, a great place to look for original souvenirs.

Return to Buenos Aires.

In the evening we will celebrate this exciting trip around the capital of Argentina with a farewell dinner where we will enjoy a Tango show, the expression of the culture of Buenos Aires. We say goodbye with exquisite food, Argentine wines and the most iconic sound and dance of the country that today is part of the world heritage.
